Saturday brought beautiful sailing conditions with a 14-16 knot northeasterly wind complete with sunshine. The wind combined with an outgoing tide made for a very choppy first race. PRO Tommy Harken attempted two starts but with the outgoing tide the eager sailors forced him to pull out the black flag which proved to be very effective on the third attempt - all clear. Team Oetgen started near the boat end and played the middle/right effectively to lead around the top mark. The team continued to extend that lead to win the first race of the day comfortably. Team Starck rounded the top mark just ahead of Jack Jones and local Teams Fairchild and Will Tyner. Starck finished in second followed by Fairchild, Tyner and Jones. For race 2 the tide had changed and was now flooding. Having a good line sight proved to be a key strategy as there was a very large line sag for the remaining three races. Team Oetgen started in

the middle of the line and played the middle left. Starck and Horowitz used right hand pressure to their advantage and rounded the top mark in first and second. Oetgen in third. Oetgen was the first to jibe midway down the run and was able to catch up to Horowitz at the leeward mark. Coming up the last beat Horowitz played left, Starck middle left and Oetgen middle right. Starck, able to control both sides, went on to take the win. After some tight maneuvering just before the finish, Oetgen edged out Horowitz for second. Fairchild and McCray were fourth and fifth.

Race 3 brought on another 5 leg race. The trend for the afternoon of right side pressure was mixed up a bit with a few shifts from the left near the top mark. Team Oetgen played the shifts and pressure well and while challenged by Team Starck lead wire to wire. Starck finished second followed by Team Harris. Youth skipper Carter Cameron and his team finished fourth and Jack Jones in

The last race of the day (race 4) brought a little bit lighter conditions but still some strong puffs. The boats on the right Starck and Bost had slightly more pressure than Oetgen on left and rounded the top mark in that order. Local Team Scarborough and Horowitz were right behind them. Oetgen jibed first and passed both Starck and Bost on the first run. Oetgen took the last race win and was

followed by Starck, Bost, Scarborough and Horowitz. Team Oetgen lead after 4 races with (1,2,1,1) 5 points, followed by Team Starck (2,1,2,2) with 7 points. Team Horowitz in third with 20 points (6,3,6,5), Team Tyner in fourth with 38 points
