Report : San Isidro Labrador Championship Buenos Aires- Argentina

"And one day ...The Lightning class returns to Argentina"

After a few years without local competitions, the Lightning Class again returned to the races at the San Isidro Labrador Championship organized by the Club Náutico San Isidro (<http://yachting.cnsi.org.ar/SIL/>), which also served for the first part of the Selective for the 2014 Sudamerican's in Ecuador. Since February, Argentina Association renewed the Lightning Class led by its Commodore Mario Fumagallo. It began with a series of activities for 2014 like race and trim clinicals, special meetings and regattas throughout the country.

With 11 boats entered, 8 races to discard the races were run in the Río de La Plata took place two daily races. Were run with light winds from all sectors and they almost no waves so the boats were happy. The winners were Ale Cloos, Maria Eugenia Zaruma and Joaquin Busquet with bullets in seven of eight races with # 13360 of the Yacht Club Olivos. Runner up another Cloos family boat (and also the YCO), helmed by Daniel Fioriti and crewed by the twins Ana and Pato Cloos. Third with # 11043 "Mancarrón" (famous Argentinian boat) with Gaby Fernández at the helm and the crew Nico Daneri and Carolina Tobar. Lightning In classic category (wooden and old national boats) was won by Nico Del Campo of Club Náutico San Isidro crewed by Manu Loitegui and Patricio Del Campo.

In addition to the social activity of CNSI, the class made two barbecues events where the group showed the camaraderie of the old days.

The next scheduled meeting is in the Laguna Setúbal in Santa Fé City in August, second part of the Selective for Sudamerican's in Salinas, December 2014.
