Two overall winners emerged in the 2012 Heineken Lightning and Tarpon National Sailing Championships at the Lagos Yacht Club in Nigeria April 21 and 22, 2012. Lloyd Crisp and members of his team emerged overall winner in the Lightning category while Guillaume Lebourdon and his crew won the Tarpon category. With their boat named "Easy Life T70" the Lloyd Crisp team crewed by David Kruyt and Anna Edris came first in the Lightning category while Guillaume Lebourdon and his crew Matthieu Seguin and Maria in the 'T30' boat won the Tarpon category. With 28 boats participating the nine race competition had five in the harbor on the first day and four offshore on the second day. Other highlights of the competition included the individual races and recognition awards category.

Commenting on the outcome of the competition, Lloyd Crisp commended Heineken for the support it has been giving to the Lagos Yacht Club and to the organizers of the championships.
