**Eligibility**: Flying Scot and Lightning class sailboats from any District in compliance with

class rules will be scored. Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached

registration form and submitting it with the required fee by the close of

registration on September 22, 2018.

**Rules**: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the 2017-2020 Racing

Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, the one design rules of

the Flying Scot Sailing Association or the International Lightning Class

Association (ILCA) and this Notice of Race except as amended by the Sailing

Instructions. Sailing instructions will be provided at check-in.

Registration:

The entry fee for Flying Scots (which includes **2 FULL** weekend meal packages) is \$80 for pre-registration (\$75 with US Sailing Discount).

The entry fee for Lightnings (which includes **3 FULL** weekend meal packages) is \$120 for pre-registration (\$115) with US Sailing Discount).
